

Mass Transportation to downtown Los Angeles from Pasadena, San Bernardino, West LA, North Hollywood, and Long Beach

To arrive for Noon to 3:00 p.m. Activities at Pershing Square

To arrive at Pershing Square events at noon, change the directions below for the 5 to 6:30 p.m. events in the following way:

- If you are coming from Pasadena or San Bernardino, once you arrive at Union Station, do not exit the metro station. Instead look for RED LINE (TO NORTH HOLLYWOOD); Pershing Square is the second stop on this line.
- If you are coming from West LA, simply get off at Red Line Station Pershing Square Station, two stops before the Union Station.
- If you are coming from Long Beach, after getting off at 7TH ST METRO CENTER STATION and getting on the Red Line, simply get off at Red Line Station Pershing Square Station, two stops before the Union Station.

5 to 6:30 p.m. Federal Building in downtown LA

Gold Line from Pasadena to Union Station for 5 p.m. protest in front of Federal Building, 300 N. Los Angeles Street

Starting from Pasadena or any of the following stations on the GOLD LINE PASADENA-LOS ANGELES

- Get on Metro Gold Line (Look for direction to UNION STATION.)
- Ending at UNION STATION.
- Exit by looking for signs leading to Alameda Street. Once outside of train station on Alameda Street, cross Alameda Street to Los Angeles Street. Los Angeles Street curves up and away from Alameda Street. Follow Alameda Street for several blocks. (Placita Olvera is the historic plaza on the right.) You will cross above freeway 101 and arrive immediately in front of the Federal Building.

For return trip, just reverse all these directions.

METROLINK from San Bernardino and cities east of Los Angeles to Union Station for 5 p.m. protest in front of Federal Building, 300 N. Los Angeles Street

- Get on MetroLink in San Bernardino or any other station (Look for direction to UNION STATION.)
- Ending at UNION STATION.
- Exit by looking for signs leading to Alameda Street. Once outside of train station on Alameda Street, cross Alameda Street to Los Angeles Street. Los Angeles Street curves up and away from Alameda Street. Follow Alameda Street for several blocks. (Placita Olvera is the historic plaza on the right.) You will cross above freeway 101 and arrive immediately in front of the Federal Building.

For return trip, just reverse all these directions.

Line from West LA to Union Station and then to the front of Federal Building, 300 N. Los Angeles Street

- Drive to and park near Western/Wilshire Metro Red Line station
- Ride Metro Rail Red Line (direction Union Station/DOWNTOWN LA)
- Get off at Pershing Square or continue on to UNION STATION
- Ending at UNION STATION.
- Exit by looking for signs leading to Alameda Street. Once outside of train station on Alameda Street, walk across Alameda Street to Los Angeles Street. Los Angeles Street curves up and away from Alameda Street. Follow Alameda Street for several blocks. (Placita Olvera is the historic plaza on the right.) You will cross above freeway 101 and arrive immediately in front of the Federal Building.

For return trip, just reverse all these directions.

Line from North Hollywood to Union Station and then to the front of Federal Building, 300 N. Los Angeles Street

- Drive to and park near North Hollywood/Universal City/Hollywood&Highland/Hollywood&Vine/Hollywood&Western/Vermont&Sunset/Vermont&Sana Monica/ Vermont&Beverly Metro Red Line stations
- Ride Metro Rail Red Line (direction Union Station/DOWNTOWN LA)
- Get off at Pershing Square or continue on to UNION STATION
- Ending at UNION STATION.
- Exit by looking for signs leading to Alameda Street. Once outside of train station on Alameda Street, walk across Alameda Street to Los Angeles Street. Los Angeles Street curves up and away from Alameda Street. Follow Alameda Street for several blocks. (Placita Olvera is the historic plaza on the right.) You will cross above freeway 101 and arrive immediately in front of the Federal Building.

For return trip, just reverse all these directions.

Blue Line from Long Beach to Union Station and then to the front of Federal Building, 300 N. Los Angeles Street

Starting from LONG BEACH, leaving from TRANSIT MALL STATION. Pay \$1.25 for one-way ticket

- Ride Metro Rail Blue Line (DOWNTOWN LA)
- Get off at 7TH ST METRO CENTER STATION
- Get on Metro Rail Red Line (Look for UNION STATION RED LINE)
- Ending at UNION STATION.
- Exit by looking for signs leading to Alameda Street. Once outside of train station on Alameda Street, walk across Alameda Street to Los Angeles Street. Los Angeles Street curves up and away from Alameda Street. Follow Alameda Street for several blocks. (Placita Olvera is the historic plaza on the right.) You will cross above freeway 101 and arrive immediately in front of the Federal Building.

For return trip, just reverse all these directions.
